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**NARRATIVE**

1. On Wednesday July 7, 2010 at approximately 2015 hours while assigned to the S736 Unit, I Officer Thorpe and Officer Ostine were flagged down by patrons waiting at the entrance to Broadway Station.

2. The patrons were all pointing at an individual later identified as Donald Kalil. He was shirtless, flailing his arms and yelling at patrons who were waiting at the bus stop. These patrons were moving away from the area in fear of their safety. I activated the blue lights and made a u-turn to further investigate but Kalil attempted to flee the area. I pursued Kalil onto the Dorchester Avenue side of the station and told Kalil to stop. I asked him for his name but he kept trying to enter his bag and pockets and he refused to stop reaching into his pockets. It was at that time, I placed Kalil into handcuffs out of concern for my safety and walked him back to the entrance of Broadway Station while proceeding with the investigation.

3. The patrons who flagged us down were waiting for the bus when Kalil exited the from the train. A family of four stated, Kalil approached several women and pulled their shirts up and attempted to touch their breast area. One of the victims had gotten on the bus. I entered the bus to ask if she would be willing to be a witness and provide testimony. She declined to give her name but stated he did pull on her shirt and tried to lift her shirt up. The family of four did not want to provide their names either.

4. A warrant check was conducted which yielded negative results. At this time Kalil was informed that he was being placed in custody for disorderly conduct. He was then transported to headquarters by the S835 Unit (Officers Bueller and Hakins) for booking in the usual manner.
